Doctoral degree

Students must obtain all credits required for graduation, participate in the public-hearing session under the guidance of their advisors, submit a doctoral thesis, and pass the final examination. Henceforth, the Graduate School of Economics will recognize that such students have acquired independent research ability in the field of economics and thus award them with a Doctorate of Philosophy in Economics.
